#### **Admission Requirements**

It is in your best interest to complete your admission file as quickly as possible. Your file will be reviewed by the Director of Graduate Admission to determine your graduate school status, generally within 7-10 business days of your file becoming complete. Admission to graduate school depends on several factors including a completed application, cumulative GPA, transcripts, resume, and letter of intent (if applicable).

#### **Transfer Credits**

A maximum of 25% of program hours may be accepted by transfer from an appropriately approved and accredited institution. The courses must be equivalent to the student's approved sequence and must be recent (within the past seven years). Courses in which you received lower than a 3.0 (B) will not be considered for transfer. Upon recommendation from the Program Director and the Dean of the College of Graduate Studies, the Dean of the College of Education may accept additional coursework.
